Overview

Southwood Export Limited is a vertically integrated producer and exporter of wood chips that manages approximately 11,000 hectares of eucalypt plantations in Southern New Zealand. Our customer requires us to be certified to global forest management standards. This provides our customer with assurance that while supplying them wood chips we are doing so in a sustainable manner.



Commitment to long-term, systematic approach to sustainable forest management We commit to a long-term, systematic approach to sustainable forest management consistent with FSC principles and Responsible Wood criteria which ensures our economic viability while minimising harm to people, fauna and non-production flora, to providing benefits from the forests.



Commitment to compliance We commit to comply with laws and regulations, local government plans, industry best practice guidelines and any other compliance obligations we have agreed to. We commit to adhere to the PEFC standard AS/NZS 4708:2021.

- Conserve biodiversity by protecting and, where appropriate, enhancing native species and ecosystems.

- Respect the rights and interests of Indigenous peoples and local communities.
- Provide safe and supportive working conditions for our employees and contractors.
- Promote responsible and transparent business practices throughout our supply chain.
- Contribute to the well-being of the local economy by generating employment and supporting local businesses.
